Rounds to be shot (Indoor or Outdoor):
20 arrow round shot at multi color targets - 40cm, 50cm, 60cm
Program may be taught by any NFAA, USA Archery, NASP or 4-H certified instructor

Advanced 2 ends 20 yds, 2 ends 30 yds 1 end 40 yds 40cm target face	15	30	45	60	75	90	95

20 ARROW INDOOR ROUND

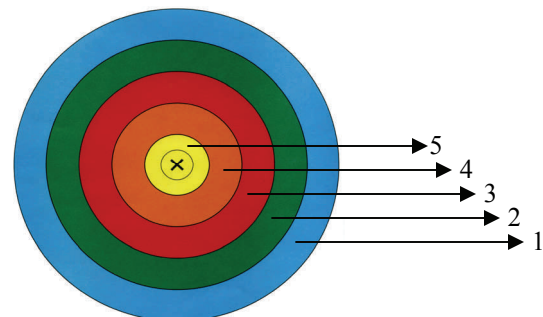
Five 4 Arrow Ends Distance and Face	Archer	Bowman	Expert	Master	Bronze Master Archer	Silver Master Archer	Gold Master Archer
Novice 10 yds - 60cm target face	15	30	45	60	75	90	95
Intermediate 20 yds - 50cm target face	15	30	45	60	75	90	95
Advanced 20 yds - 40cm target face	15	30	45	60	75	90	95

Scoring on all faces is 5 for center and 4-3-2-1 for outer rings. The "x" center ring is a tie-breaker and is part of the "5" ring. Total possible score is 100 points for both indoor and outdoor rounds. The arrow needs to touch the separating line to score the higher value.

Three levels of proficiency: "Novice", "Intermediate", and "Advanced"
Seven levels of achievement: "Archer", "Bowman", "Expert", and "Master" (each level can be recognized by a patch)
Bronze, Silver and Gold medals can be awarded for further achievement.
